

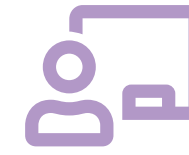

Evaluate, analyze, and protect America's historic structures.



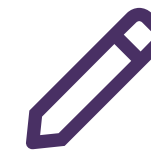
Archaeologists
